Folder 5 Student Exercises 1987

Scope and Content This File contains collections of exercises written by students from sociology class 148 held in Spring 1987, ten years after another soc. 148 class (see OM1 Folder4), supervised by Harold Garfinkel. However, unlike the seminar before from 1977, the exercises remained uncommented. The exercises generally consist of a written reflection either a typescript or an autograph and related materials they did reflect on. The last exercises in the folder were stored in an extra file with seven different compartments. Some evidence suggests that this file was compiled by one student and filed in as a whole. According to their own labelings there have to be eight, but overall there are just seven compartments. The creator of the exercises seems to be a student in class soc. 148 called Randy White. One of the typescripts names him the author.
